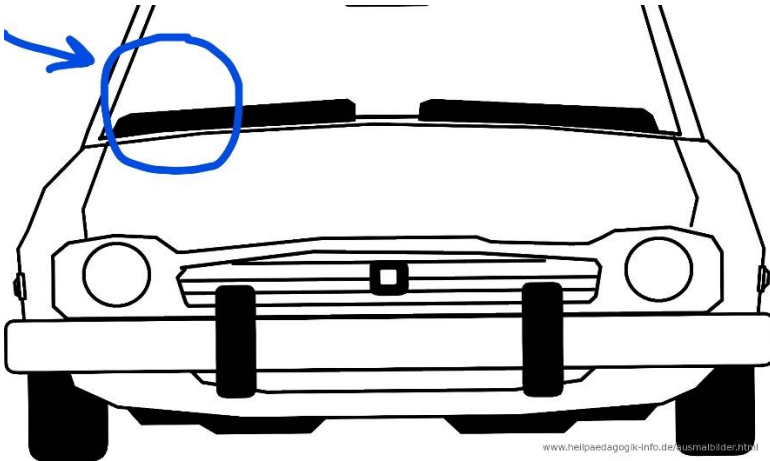


The First Presbyterian Church of Everett Parking Policy

Parking at the First Presbyterian Church of Everett (north and alley spaces) is for members and member events.

Members must display parking “window clings” on the lower front passenger side windshield.



Temporary “paper passes” are required, by visitors or guests, always.

Parking Passes may be obtained from the Church Office or the Coordinator of a meeting or event.

Deliveries and Tradespeople (Plumbers, Electricians, etc. doing work at the Church) do not require parking passes.

Those not displaying proper parking passes may be towed, at the owner’s expense.

Towing of those not displaying proper parking passes is at the discretion of the Church Staff as guided by the Head of Staff.

Parking passes are not required for:

Sundays, Special Worship Services, Wednesday afternoon & evening for Dinner at the Bell, Weddings, Memorials

Parking may be further restricted to parking only for specific events including but not limited to:

Circle Meetings, Book Club, Senior Presbyterian Adult Ministry Lunches, Presbyterian Women Meetings, Presbytery Gatherings
